Double Degree Programs

The Articulation Arrangement between China Jiliang University (CJLU) and The World University of Bangladesh (WUB) documents the intention of the institutions to engage in a general program of collaboration for future benefit. This Articulation Arrangement documents the Double Degree arrangement for the college of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering at CJLU and the Faculty of Science and Engineering at WUB. This is an exclusive contract between the two institutions in the field of Mechatronics and Mechanical Engineering. According to MOU the WUB and Jiliang University a student will have to study first 2 years in WUB and 2nd 2 years in Jiliang University and certificate will be issued from WUB and CJLU. A student must complete 143 credit hours which include:

1. 83 credits hours in WUB and a student must maintain CGPA 3.00 scale of 4.00.
2. 60 Credits hours in Jiliang University respecting.

However, the students who will not go to China will complete 161 credit hours to complete the full course in World University of Bangladesh and obtain certificate of graduation.



About China Jiliang University (CJLU)

China Jiliang University (CJLU) is the only university in the world dedicated to metrology, standardization, quality supervision, inspection and quarantine. It was upgraded as China Institute of Metrology with the approval of the Ministry of Education of China in 1985. It was renamed as China Jiliang University in 2016. The People's Government of Zhejiang Province and the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China signed an agreement on joint construction on China Jiliang University in 2017. Prof. Song Mingshun is the President of the University.

Admission Policy:

- ◆ Two years of study undertaking the Bachelor of Engineering in the general area of Mechatronics Engineering at WUB; followed by,
- ◆ Two years of study undertaking the Bachelor of Engineering in the major of Mechatronics Engineering at CJLU in Hangzhou, China.

Note: Students who do not secure as award CGPA of 3.00 as a scale of 4.00 in the first two years of study at WUB will not be able to transfer to CJLU. They have to complete running program, it Third year & Four year in CJLU.

Based on mutual agreement between WUB and CJLU, completion of the last two years of study at CJLU can be credited back to WUB to fulfill the graduation requirements for the last two years of study of the Bachelor of Engineering at WUB.

Cost of Study CJLU

Students who articulate to CJLU shall be responsible for paying the standard international tuition fee, as published by CJLU for International students enrolled in the Bachelor of Engineering to CJLU at the time of registration of each year. Currently, the normal tuition for each student is RMB 18,000 Yuan a year. A 40% discount is offered when the agreement is signed for the program, that is, each student RMB 10,800 Yuan a year. But the tuition fees are reviewed by CJLU annually based on actual costs, and probably an increase of less than 15% every year.

FINANCIAL AID

WUB provides a number of scholarships and financial grant to the deserving students to meet their tuition fees . To be considered for this Scholarship, a student must achieve for both SSC and HSC (or its equivalents): Golden GPA-5.00=100%, GPA-5 (1 Golden)= 80%, Normal GPA-5=70%, GPA 4.26-4.99=45%, GPA-3.5-4.25=35%, GPA 3.00-3.49-25% and GPA 2.50-2.99=20%. Special scholarship for female students, siblings, spouse, athletes, group and many other. Best performers of each semester will enjoy full free scholarship for that semester.
